CYO Dances are for SS Philip & James 6th, 7th & 8th Grade students. The dance is **ONLY** open to registered students SS Philip & James Parish. We want our kids to have fun in a safe environment, so please read the following with your child and sign for your child to participate.

Dance Rules & Code of Conduct

Dress Code:

This is a Catholic Youth organization. Appropriate dress is required. Please be neat and use common sense! For girls: No skimpy tops, camis, spaghetti string shirts, crop tops, strapless, halter-tops, short-shorts, micro minis. For boys: shirts must be either tucked into the pants or extend below the waistline; pants and shorts must be secured around the waist. For both boys and girls: shirts with inappropriate sayings, graphics, etc. are not allowed. Any child coming inappropriately dressed will not be admitted to the dance and will be required to call home to be picked up.

Dancing:

- All styles of dancing must comply with standards of Christian morality, standards that include modesty and safety. Chaperones in attendance will be the final judges of the appropriateness of dance styles. Chaperones will confront any student behavior or dancing deemed inappropriate.

Other Items:

- **No Cell phones, cameras or video cameras.**
- No Glow-in-the-dark necklaces, mouthpieces, laser lights or other lighted paraphernalia.

Code of Conduct:

- No foul language.
- Respect others and obey all chaperones.
- Respect school property. Do not damage or take anything not belonging to you.
- No hanging out in the bathrooms.
- Students absent from school the day of the dance may not attend.
- SS Philip & James Parish, School, and CYO are not responsible for the loss of any personal items.

Students must arrive no later than 7:45 and no one is permitted to leave until the dance is over at 10PM. If a parent needs to pick up a child prior to 9:45, we require that you come in and sign them out at the door. Otherwise, students will be dismissed to the parking lot via the chaperones at 10. We appreciate your promptness in picking them up at this time.

Upon paying the admission, and gaining entry to the cafeteria, all students are subject to the supervision and direction of adult chaperones. The chaperones are the approved supervisors of all CYO Dances and act in the place of parents. All attendees are subject to the Dance Rules and Code of Conduct.

Students violating these above rules will have their parents phoned and will be asked to leave the dance without a refund.
